Abstract: The eating habits developed during childhood form the basis of an early nutrition programming that is reflected in adult life. It is known that children eat what they like, and that they like a given product if its taste is pleasant. The present research work tries to analyze the variables that determine children to like or not to like the flavor of the vegetables, as vegetables are a healthy food and, therefore, highly recommendable. It is concluded that both a genetic predisposition towards sensitivity to the bitter taste of vegetables and learning, mediated by prenatal and postnatal experience with vegetable flavors, to accept these flavors influence liking for and consumption of vegetables in the child population. However, the specific impact that the interaction of these factors has on the consumption of vegetables from child populations in specific regions, such as that of the Basque Country or Euskadi, remains unknown, which is recommended to be investigated in the future.

Abstract: At the end of the 19th century, a new culture emerged in Bilbao around the consumption of *txakoli*. Economic development boosted the birth of a new social class avid for places of leisure and one of these spaces were the txakolies that marked Bilbao. The *txakoli*es were an outdoor picnic where *Txakoli* was tasted, a variety of wine that was cultivated and made there, accompanied by dishes of simple invoice. From being places of family reunion with the industrial revolution of the late nineteenth century to these locals also began to go from the bourgeois to the Bilbao workers and they gave rise to habits and customs peculiar to these precincts. Many of these establishments led to renowned restaurants of the time in which traditional cuisine was combined with the new trendy culinary currents, encouraging the appearance of a fusion kitchen that the basis of the current Basque cuisine.
